

One of the new projects in the parish this Lent is the Legion of Mary sponsored Lighthouse Catholic Media CD program. A rack was been placed in the back of our parish church displaying a number of different titles, including one I recently played in my car while driving about, entitled *Untold Stories of the Last Three Popes*, by Bishop John Magee. It was fascinating, and at more than one point, moved beyond the interesting to the deeply inspirational.

Bishop Magee was one of the Monsignors selected by Pope Paul VI to serve as secretary for him during the final four years of his life. Bishop Magee offers a number of very interesting stories about this experience, including the question Pope Paul VI asked him, "Would you like to know the key to my spiritual life?" Another important fact offered in the story of Pope Paul VI was his connection to August 6. Furthermore, as a very young boy, the future Pope Paul VI met St. Pius X who happened to be a friend of his father. Wonderful stories.

Bishop Magee served the next two popes following the death of Paul VI, and provides a wealth of information about his relationship with Pope John Paul I and about the first four years of the pontificate of Pope John Paul II. By the end of the CD, you'll be wishing for more, and glad you purchased the CD and listened to it.

The Lighthouse Catholic Media program has been well received among parishioners, and within days of offering the CDs in the back of the church, the rack nearly emptied. The Legionnaire responsible for the program ordered more titles, including *How to Bring Fallen Away Catholics Back*; *The True Meaning of Easter*; *Three Days That Changed the World*; *The Fourth Cup*; *The Lamb's Supper*; and, *The Significance of Holy Saturday and Applying it to Your Life*. One hundred and thirty-five new CDs are now in the rack! Take a look. Become part of this inspirational and informative program.
